- iii. Apps here you will find helpful policy decision making tools like a Risk Matrix – Profitability assessment, CountyPro – SCO/ECO historical tool DairyPro – DRP insurance quoter, LivestockPro – LRP insurance quoter.

b. Risk Matrix

The Risk Matrix provides producers with a clear picture of profitability per acres after including your insurance coverage, your marketing, trades, and cost of production.

Your crop agent can take you through the optional coverage offerings to help you decide the best policy for your operation.

3) My Documents (Coming Soon)

This will be the future home for policy documents that your insurance agent has given you access to. Documents could include Schedule of Insurance, copy of your Production report, 578s, etc.

4) Apps

Under your Apps Menu item, you can select links to your Risk Matrix *See Risk Matrix description above*, CountyPro, as well as quoting tools for Dairy and Livestock policies.

a. CountyPro

i. Using CountyPro you and your agent can help you decide if SCO 75-86%, ECO 86-90%, or ECO 86-95% should be added to your policy. The History table allows you to see Historical performance of SCO/ECO. The History Chart allows you to see yield trends. The SCO / ECO Visual allows you to see how SCO / ECO looks stacked on top of your RP base coverage.

b. DairyPro

- i. Your agent can help you decide the best options for your Dairy operation and utilizing DairyPro together can help you better understand the best Quarter and options to select.
- ii. Please note you cannot bind coverage or purchase a policy on the DairyPro quoting tool.

c. LivestockPro

- i. Your agent can help you decide the best options for your Livestock operation and utilizing LivestockPro together can help you better understand the best Market Price Endorsement to elect.
- ii. Please note you cannot bind coverage or purchase a policy on the LivestockPro quoting tool.
